DanceAspen elevated its main stage productions from four in 2022 to **six stellar performances** at the Historic Wheeler Opera House, drawing full audiences. These were complemented by **twelve dynamic performances** in unconventional and creative settings throughout Aspen, underscoring the organization's steadfast commitment to bringing the joy of dance to every corner of the community.

WINTER PROGRAM | March 17 & 18, 2023

DanceAspen's 4th main stage performance featured a new creation by world-renowned choreographer, Yin Yue, alongside acclaimed works by Penny Saunders and Sebastian Kloberg. The performance also included new pieces by inhouse choreographers Matthew Gilmore, Blake Krapels, and a film by Madeleine Scott.





SOLSTICE | August 25 & 26, 2023

DanceAspen's first summer presentation at the Wheeler Opera House brought a brand new work by award-winning choreographer, Matthew Neenan, to the stage. DanceAspen was also honored to be the first American company to premiere two works by cuttingedge creator Cayetano Soto.

This family-friendly production at the Wheeler Opera House was an expansion of the Holiday Pop-Up Series the company created in 2022. This event was a festive celebration featuring a versatile performance from DanceAspen, followed by a meet and greet with refreshments and photo opportunities with the dancers. With tickets selling out almost instantly, this event is poised to become a cherished Aspen Holiday tradition.



IN-HOUSE CREATIONS

DanceAspen is unique for its commitment to fostering creativity within its own members. By empowering our performers to hone their choreographic skills, DanceAspen cultivates a vibrant atmosphere of innovation and collaboration, resulting in unforgettable pieces that resonate with audiences.



In 2023, DanceAspen employed 9 talented company dancers and was able to achieve a remarkable 11% increase in artist weekly compensation. This significant boost in wages profoundly enhances the livelihoods of DanceAspen's artists, empowering them to devote themselves to their craft and lead rich, rewarding lives within the vibrant community of Aspen.

ADULT CLASSES


